Enjoy your new Bible Guess Who cards!

Below, you'll find three templates. Choose only one per game, but be sure to print three copies of it—one for you, one for your opponent, and one to serve as the deck you'll draw your mystery person from. Cardstock works best, but regular paper is doable, too.

Cut out the characters, but keep each sheet/deck separate from the others. Load your set into your 2 Guess Who gameboards. If you don't have a gameboard, lay out in front of you facing up.

You and your opponent each draw a card from the deck. Keep it hidden from each other. This is the character your opponent must guess.

Play begins when one player asks one question to the opponent. The question should help narrow down who the opponent's mystery person is, such as, "Is your person a boy?" If so, turn all female cards face down. Now it's your opponent's turn to ask you a question about your mystery person.

When a player is ready to correctly guess who the mystery person is, the guess will be that player's question. If incorrect, no other question is allowed until his or her next turn.

Play ends when one a mystery person is correctly guessed.


